Examination by Coroner Egan.

Q--- How did he act over there?

A--- He bought one drink after I got there, but he and Holland I think were drinking all afternoon, but it was pretty near four o'clock when I came up from town.

Q--- What time did you start from Walkerville ?

A--- I think about six o'clock.

Q--- Where did this happen?

A--- Right near the Lexington Mill opposite the church.

Q--- Who got there first?

A--- We all got there about the same time?

Q--- How did he come to do this?

A--- I don't know any reason.

Q--- You did not have any trouble with him?

A--- No quarrell at all, I was talking to Holland, and was trying to get him to go back. I told him not to go with the dago, as we had no money, and we did not want to get him to spend his money, that he would get him some where and give him the worst of it.

STATEMENT OF JOHN SULLIVAN.

Denny gve me the ten cents and I just got it in my pocket when he started to cut me in the back. ~~X~~I got about fifteen feet when I heard Holland holler, "Come back Jack I am stuck," I went back and Holland was sittinb up/ and the Dago was running away.

Q--- You do not know of any reason at all for his doing this?

A--- No, when he saw me stagger he thought he had me he had got me and I guess he wanted to get holland as it would cover everything up.

Q--- You never had an quarrell with him?

A--- Not a word, Denny and I was talking, but did not say a word to him.
